

Mackay Mine Hill Trail

This self-guided tour includes approximately 15 miles of trails accessible to all modes of transportation, 5.5 miles are advisable for high-clearance vehicles only and 4 more miles are open to ATVs, motorcycles and non-motorized uses.



Location—Mackay Area



Directions to trailhead: First, pick up a trail brochure in the town of Mackay. Then turn onto Main Street heading southwest. Follow the signs for the trailhead.

The South Custer Historical Society and White Knob Historical Preservation Committee put together an interpretive auto tour around the historical Mine Hill, just west of Mackay.

Along the way you can see historic mine buildings, the Shay Railroad Trestle, aerial tramway towers, historic cabins and more.

The trail is generally open May to October, depending on weather conditions. Facilities are located in the town of Mackay.

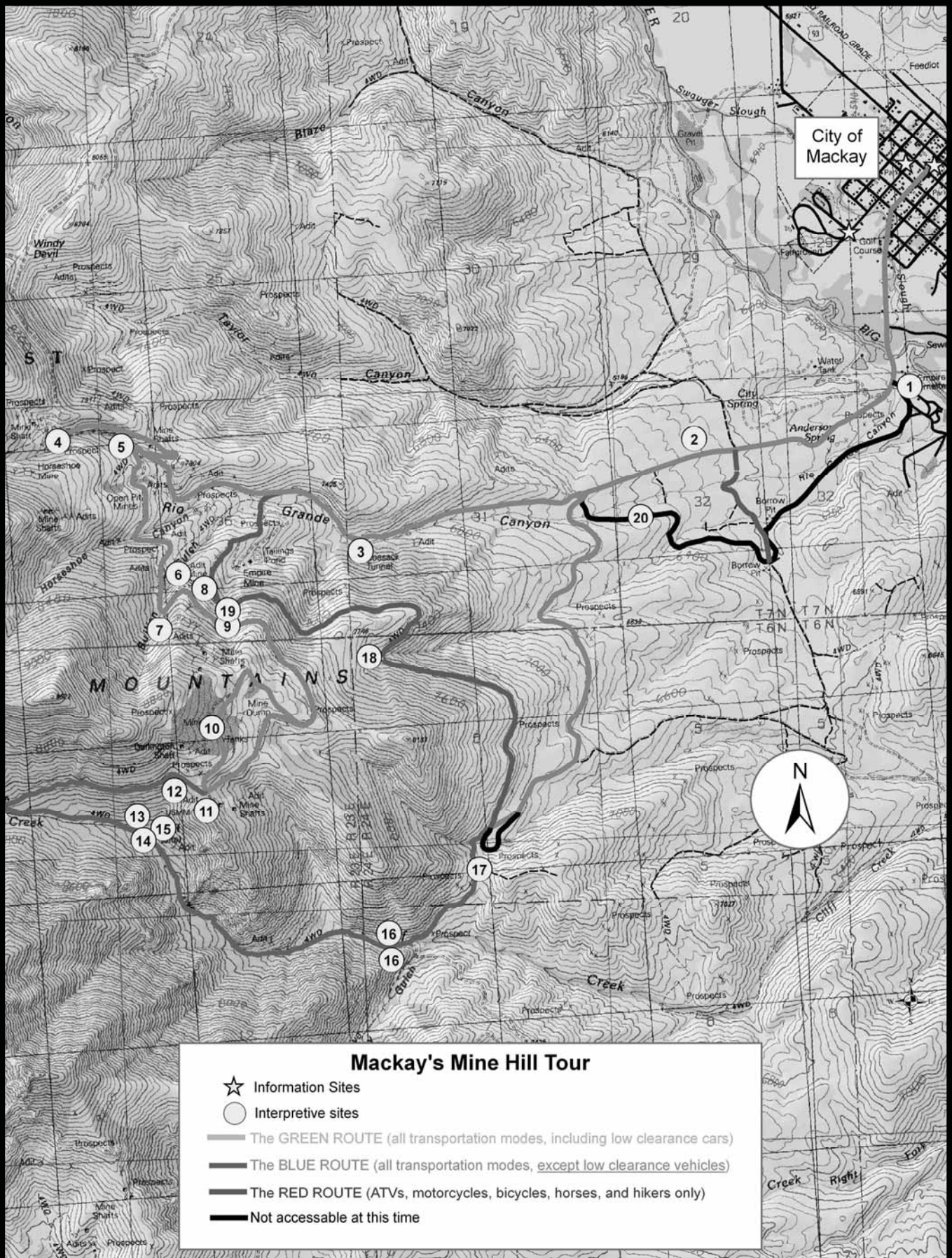
